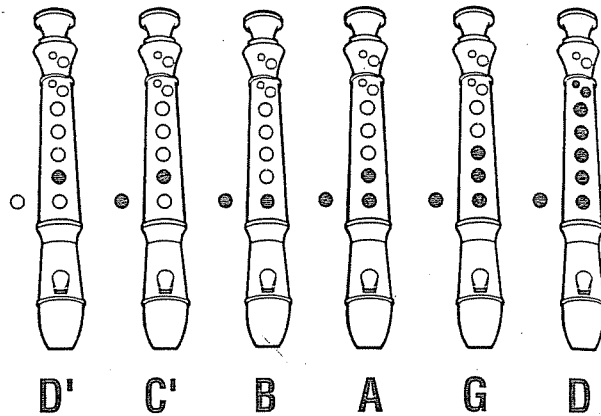

- Recorder fingerings for D', C', B, A, G, D
- $\frac{3}{4}$ time signature
- Repeat Sign
- Trill
- $\frac{6}{8}$ time signature
- D.S. al Fine, Fine
- Tie

REPORTER'S NOTE: Recorder 1 plays notes with stems up. Recorder 2 plays notes with stems down. Beware of the tempo and meter change at measure 17. Have your teacher play an example of it before you begin.
